Please find enclosed my Complaint against the Pascagoula School District. Also enclosed is the Notice of Hearing. This Cause has been scheduled for hearing on August 23, 2012 at 9AM at the Jackson County Courthouse, located at 3104 Magnolia Street, Pascagoula, Mississippi.

I have received a copy of the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss to be heard on July 17, 2012. I had asked the Court Clerk what I needed to do in order to appeal to County Court. She needed a certified check for the fee which I went and obtained. She then instructed me to call the Court Administrator, Kaydene Stanley in a couple weeks for further instructions. In the mean time, I wrote the "Make-a-Deal" letter to Mr. Rodolfich to try and settle this issue out of court. When I called Ms Stanley, she scheduled a court hearing and instructed me to write letters to all parties. I was unaware that I needed to send a copy of the actual notice and did not know there was any time frame involved. I delayed hoping for a response to my offer, but I always intended to give 30 days notice. I hope this case will not be dismissed over some minor technicality. Mr. Sessoms is very much aware of the appeal through my written and oral communications with him, and I am sending the proper notification and certificate of service today. It is more than a month before the court date. Although I may not understand all the legal technicalities of the Defendant's arguments regarding rules of procedure, I think the purpose of the rule regarding notification of the parties involved has been followed.
